### Science: Sea Urchins

We've read about Anna collecting sea urchins twice so far. Once in Chapter 4 and once again in Chapter 7. We don't know what she was going to do with them, but by learning more about sea urchins, we can make some educated guesses.

According to KidsKonnect.com, a sea urchin is a ball-shaped echinoderm (echinoderms are a group of animals that live on the ocean floor) with long, pointy and moveable spines all over its body. The term "urchin" comes from the old French word, "herichun," and Latin word, "ericius" which means hedgehog. This is fitting because a sea urchin does look kind of like a hedgehog.
